### SPEAKER

She returned to college at PCC in 2002 in the Management and Supervisory Development program, planning to find a position with state or local government. Her studies soon migrated to computer technology and social science. She is an administrative assistant in the Visual and Performing Arts and Design Division office at the Sylvania campus and is pursuing a transfer degree in Gerontology. She is also an active volunteer in the Student Resource Initiative—the Wisdom Keepers—and is a member of the PCC Taskforce on Aging. ### DIRECTIONS

**From the West:** Cross Ross Island Bridge/Hwy. 26 (East), which becomes SE Powell Blvd. Go 2.8 miles, turn left on SE 58<sup>th</sup> Ave. Go 0.5 mile, turn right on SE Division St. Courtyard is on the left, approximately another 0.2 mile. Meeting is in the lobby of the Mt. Hood wing of the Courtyard Plaza.

**From I-84 East:** Take exit #3 (SE 58<sup>th</sup> Ave./Providence Hospital) to where it “T”s into SE Glisan. Turn left onto Glisan, then right at the next light (SE 60<sup>th</sup>). Cross Burnside, continue on 60<sup>th</sup> for about a mile. Turn left onto SE Division St.; Courtyard is on the left about another 0.2 mile. Meeting is in the lobby of the Mt. Hood wing of the Courtyard Plaza.

**From I-205:** Take the SE Division St. exit, turn west on SE Division, continue for approximately 1.5 mile. Courtyard will be on the right. Meeting is in the lobby of the Mt. Hood wing of the Courtyard Plaza.

**From the South:** See I-205 directions above **OR** take McLoughlin Blvd./99E north, turn right onto SE Division. Go approximately 2 miles. Courtyard will be on the left (0.2 miles past SE 60<sup>th</sup>). Meeting is in the lobby of the Mt. Hood wing of the Courtyard Plaza.
