SPEAKER:

Officer John Holbrook is a uniformed officer with the Central Precinct of the Portland Police Bureau. He has been a police officer for 14 years. He worked drug and vice for 7 years, where he was involved in investigating and dismantling methamphetamine labs. He has also investigated drug dealers involved in cocaine, marijuana, heroin, meth and prescription drugs. He lived in Argentina for two years and speaks Spanish.
