Margaret Neal, PhD, is the Director of the Institute on Aging at Portland State University in Portland, Oregon. She teaches courses in the Graduate Certificate in Gerontology program and the doctoral programs in Urban Studies and Public Administration and Policy at PSU. She also is the Past President of the Oregon Gerontological Association, a statewide non-profit professional development organization aimed at enhancing the skills of those who serve elders and their families.

For the past several years, Dr. Neal has focused her research on the challenges and opportunities faced by individuals who are balancing employment with providing informal care to elderly family members or friends and the ways in which the public and private sectors can assist these caregivers. She has received several grants and written numerous articles, book chapters, and three books on these topics. Her additional research and teaching interests center around Hispanic elders and health promotion, global aging issues, older workers, and retirement.
