**Maria V. Prokhorova, MD**, is a Board Certified Psychiatrist. She completed her residency training in psychiatry in George Washington University, Washington, DC. She was a ward physician in the Oregon State Hospital (OSH) Geriatric Psychiatry program for 4 years, then in 2003 became a supervising physician for the program. Dr. Prokhorova is now an interim Chief Medical Officer for OSH. She also worked in the Crisis Triage Center and in Polk County Mental Health (Enhanced Care Unit in Dallas retirement village and outpatients) and was a consultant for Cascadia (Premier Enhanced Care facility).

**Maureen C. Nash, MD**, is a staff psychiatrist at the Tuality Center for Geriatric Psychiatry. Dr. Nash is double boarded in psychiatry and internal medicine. She is a preceptor for the Pacific University School of Physician Assistant Studies.
